LEIS COUNTRY STORE - CORN FED BEEF PROGRAM

500 – 700 lb. Beef Cattle

Introduce cattle to FFM 35% Steakmaker Supplement NU (Plain) and whole dry corn. Feed whole corn at 5.0 lbs/head/day (2.25 kg/head/day) along with 35% Steakmaker Supplement Pellets at rate of 2.0 lbs/head/day (0.9 kg/head/day) to provide a constant supply of energy, protein, vitamins and minerals (Note: gradually increase corn up to 10.0 lbs/head/day). The FFM **35% Steakmaker Supplement** always remains at a constant feeding rate of 2.0 lbs/head/day (0.9 kg/head/day)

Salt – Offer free choice salt in block form

Hay – Baleage Feeding – Hay and or Baleage can be limit fed to cattle. This is especially important if using shavings or sawdust as bedding. Try to limit the amount of Hay to 5.0 lbs/head/day

Water - Fresh clean water should be readily available

700 – 1,000 lb. Beef Cattle

FFM Steakmaker Supplement NU, Plain – feed at the rate of 2.0 lbs/head/day (0.9 kg/head/day)

Whole Dry Corn – feed whole corn to appetite, (cattle should consume 10 – 15 lbs/head/day)

Salt – Offer free choice salt in block form

Hay – Baleage Feeding – Hay and or Baleage can be limit fed to cattle. This is especially important if using shavings or sawdust as bedding. Try to limit the amount of Hay to 5.0 lbs/head/day

Water - Fresh clean water should be readily available

1,000 – 1,300 lb - (finishing weight) Beef Cattle

FFM Steakmaker Supplement NU, Plain - feed at the rate of 2.0 lbs/head/day (0.9 kg/head/day)

Whole Dry Corn – feed whole dry corn to appetite, cattle will consume a lot of corn as they reach this weight. Corn should be fed at 1.5 – 2% of body weight (15 – 25 lbs/head/day)

Salt – Offer free choice salt in block form

Hay – Baleage Feeding – Hay and or Baleage can be limit fed to cattle. This is especially important if using shavings or sawdust as bedding. Try to limit the amount of Hay to 5.0 lbs/head/day

Water - Fresh clean water should be readily available
